8th BDI-Workshop on SDScom

When quantity of compliance data grows, efficiency is the key to quality. During ECHA's REACH Review Action 3, a broad support for XML-based data exchange in the chemical supply chain became obvious. As it is industry's task to define this exchange, SDScom continues to broaden its scope. The latest SDScom version is now covering U.S. safety data sheets and is heading towards full supply chain coverage, with a defined workflow to take data from Exposure Scenarios into Safety Data Sheets and to the end user.

This Workshop provides an introduction into the latest changes of SDScom, including insight into a first project based on version 5.0. In the afternoon session, you can feed your questions and requirements directly into development and have 1:1 talks to learn about the implementation as well as the future of digital supply chain communication.
